BLOOD GLUCOSE CURVE PROCEDURE

We need to monitor all animals who have diabetes with a regular blood glucose curve. This curve allows us to get a picture of how the treatment is going. It is important that our first reading is taken before the insulin and food has been given.

This is a procedure that requires you to attend a morning appointment with the veterinarian then your pet will stay with us for the day. During their stay we need to take a number of blood tests using a glucometer.

After the initial blood reading, the vet will watch you administer the morning insulin and we will feed them breakfast from the food that you supply.

It is vital that you follow some basic steps at home before arriving at the clinic. If these steps are not followed this may prevent us from doing the curve and it will need to be rescheduled for another day.

Important steps for you to follow:

- 1. DO NOT give the insulin on the morning of your appointment
- 2. DO NOT feed the morning of your appointment
- 3. Arrive to your appointment on time.
- 4. BRING in your pets insulin and syringe for you to administer with the vet.
- 5. BRING your pets normal breakfast to be given by us after the insulin injection.
