

## Home Care After Your Pet's Anaesthetic/Sedation

- \* Keep your pet warm, either inside or sheltered from the elements.
- \* Make sure that your pet is not disturbed by other members of the family, including other animals.
- \* Your pet may be drowsy for 24 - 48 hours after the procedure.
- \* Your pet may have a decreased appetite for 24 hours after the procedure. Feed small amounts and have plenty of fresh water available.
- \* Any shaved areas of examination or injection should grow back within 3 - 6 weeks.
- \* Medicate your pet as instructed and complete the whole course.
- \* Any bandages (if applied) are to be kept dry, clean and odourless. A revisit appointment is necessary in 3 days to check the bandages.
- \* Watch for urine / faecal output and food and water intake.
- \* Watch for any unusual behaviour of your pet.
